Allies just see you as a she/her man and don't expect much else from you. In their vision of gender there are she/her, they/them, he/him Men and she/her, they/them/ he/him Women, they don't say the man or woman part out loud but under the surface they feel this way. "Male" is like a demon's mark you can't fully wash from yourself, you carry that burden for the rest of your life like some dark and brooding anti-hero. I do my best to eliminate dysphoria and live your life but as a whole you will always be the male "other" to them.

I dislike misogyny and sexism. Not to validate my own gender and feel like one of the girls, but because I just see it as the truth. Women experience a disproportionate of sexual violence and get accused of seeking clout when they call it out. They can't engage in any hobby without being accused of doing it for male attention, and if they don't engage in those hobbies they're accused of having boring personalities. I see feminist conclusions as a truth and not an accessory to my gender identity. But I will never fully integrate into their world. That doesn't mean I can't individually form close friendships with people of the female sex, that will probably always be something I do, but I can never fully belong in their world. They don't owe me that, simultaneously I won't kneel down and kiss their feet begging for scraps like some spineless male dog.
